Unaffiliated Dressage

(Qualifiers for Championship show on July 12th)

Warm up in large sand arena and tests in rubber track arena.

Class One – British Dressage Introductory A (2008) Walk and Trot only

For horse and rider combinations who have not been placed in a dressage class.

Class Two – British Dressage Preliminary 1 (2006)

For horse and rider combinations who have not won a dressage class.

Class Three – British Dressage Preliminary 14 (2006)

Class Four – British Dressage Novice 28 (2008)

Class Five – British Dressage Novice 32 (2002)

The first six in each class (disregarding those already qualified) will qualify for respective championships at the July show. Rosette for highest placed Wessex Riding Club member in each class (please state on entry if member). Rosettes will go to sixth place.
