Dressage – 10am

- Class 1 – BD Introductory Test No A.
- Class 2 – BD Preliminary Test No 4
- Class 3 – BD Preliminary Test No 7
- Class 4 – BD Novice Test No 20
- Class 5 – BD Novice Test No 25

Rosettes to 6th place in each class and points for 1st six. Championship rosette for person gaining the most points in dressage classes on the day. £11.50

Ring One – Show Jumping – 10am

- Class 6 – Novice Jumping
Fences not to exceed 1'9". For horse and rider combinations never to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a jumping class.
- Class 7 – Novice Jumping
Fences not to exceed 2'. For horse and rider combinations never to have been placed 1st in a jumping class.
- Class 8 – Open Jumping
Fences not to exceed 2'3"
- Class 9 – Open Jumping
Fences not to exceed 2'6"
- Class 10 – Open Jumping
Fences not to exceed 2'9"
- Class 11 – Open Jumping
Fences not to exceed 3'
- Class 12 – Open Jumping
Fences not to exceed 3'3".

Obedience

Class 57 - Starters:
Limited to dogs who have never placed in the first six at an Open show.
Heel on Lead, Recall (no finish), Retrieve handlers article, 1/2 minute Down Stay.
 Class 58 - Improvers:
Limited to dogs who have never won a first prize at an Open show.
Heel on Lead, Recall with finish, Retrieve judges article, 1 minute Sit Stay, 2 minute Down Stay.
 Class 58 – Open:
Heel off lead, recall with finish, retrieve judges article. 1 minute sit stay, 2 minute down stay.
All dog classes £2 on the day. Rosettes to 6th place.

Mounted Games – not before 3pm.

£1.50 per race. Races to be decided on day but will include bending, Monte Carlo, mug race, flag race, sack race etc etc.
 Rosettes 1st – 6th in each race. May be divided into heats depending on entries. Lead rein, 14 years and under and open.
