

## Stabling

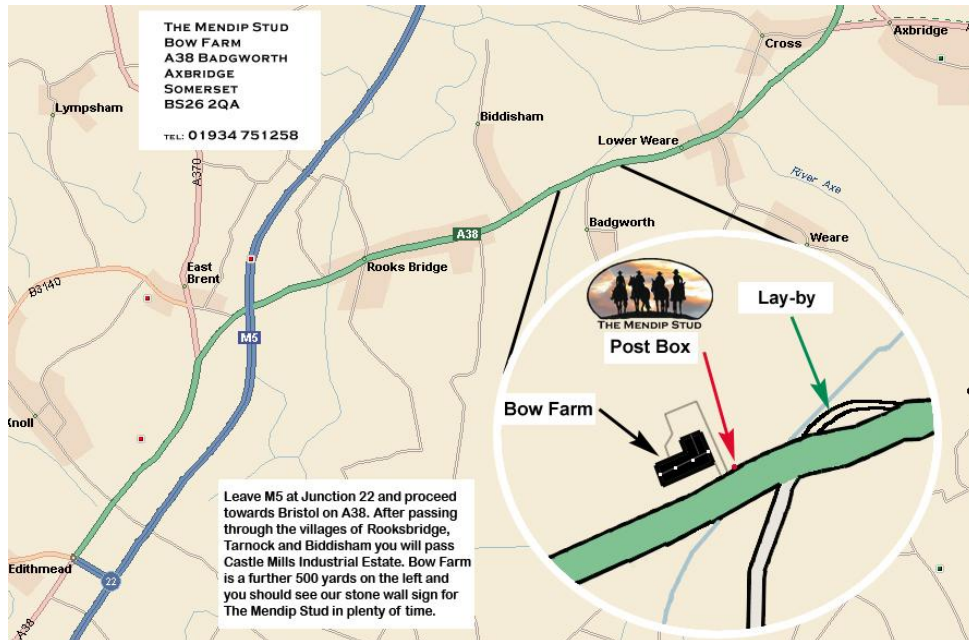

## Health & Safety

The organising committee will take all reasonable steps to ensure the Health & Safety of spectators, competitors and everyone else present. For these to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions given by the organiser and stewards.

## Classes

Hi Point awards: Open, Amateur, Novice Rider & Youth

Points gained by Area 3 members count towards the trophy for the overall show Hi point winner of 2010. Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes except Open & Amateur where they will be to 4<sup>th</sup> place.

## Conditions of Entry

1. Reasonable precautions have been taken to ensure the safety of everyone present, but neither WES nor the proprietors of The Mendip Stud will be responsible for any accident, injury, illness, loss, damage or expense incurred to any person, animal or item at the show from whatever the cause arising. All entries are at the sole risk of the competitor.
2. All objections must be in writing to the show manager and be received on the day of the show accompanied by a £10 deposit, which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
3. The organisers, at their own discretion, may at any time, before, or during the show, reject any entry whether the same has been accepted or not, and their decision in this respect, without giving a reason, shall be final. The organisers shall have the power to eject from the showground any person whose behaviour they consider objectionable.
4. All competitors must have third party horse insurance and by entering are stating that they have such insurance in force.
5. All competitors must be members of the Western Equestrian Society and must be conversant with the rules of the society. All classes will be judged under the rules laid out in the current WES Rule Book. Neither the Society nor the organisers will be held responsible for the failure of any competitor in understanding the rules
6. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and any mess must be cleared up by the owner/handler.
7. No unauthorised person may enter a ring.
8. All riders whether competing or not must wear appropriate headgear when mounted (no baseball caps). Riders choosing to wear a western hat do so at their own risk. Anyone disregarding WES Rule 30 will be asked to leave the showground and will forfeit entry fees.
9. The Judge reserves the right to ask any competitor to withdraw if considered to be not in control of their horse or causing a problem to others, and the Judge may stop the class at any point if necessary.
10. Classes may be divided, combined or cancelled at the organisers' discretion.
11. No refunds of entry fees will be made unless a Medical or Veterinary certificate is received before the show day with an SAE for return, or presented to the Secretary on the show day before the start of the class.

Arenas will be open for practise from 08:00 on the 26<sup>th</sup> September.

Trail obstacles will be set up in the Indoor arena.

Bar, soft drinks and food available all day.
